Module VI Focus:

This module focuses on giving you professional level tools beyond the apprenticeship level necessary for energy, spiritual and vibrational healers. Many of these therapies are taught purely from an experiential point of view. Although this is good from a personal development perspective, a practitioner wanting to work from a professional context needs a stronger professional foundation to support clients and congregants. There is a great deal of research in this field that we can benefit from when providing healing ministry services to clients and congregants. In addition, this module gives you the opportunity to explore serious, solid, scientific research in a broad range of vibrational medicine, healing therapies and holistic health. This module prepares you for registration with the OIIM Registration Board as an Interfaith Spiritual and Energy Healer (RSPh) upon completion of this diploma program and the pre-requisite CASC program.

Foundational Resources for Module VI:

Welcome to the NTI Interfaith Spiritual & Energy Healing Diploma Program. We have chosen a number of multi-media resources, textbooks, power points and articles for each course within this module which we believe will provide you with a balanced and sound foundation in the topic area that it explores. However, there are a few resources which we feel are relevant to all the courses and which should be studied to provide a foundation or which will act as a reference when needed. Course: SPHEAL B-801-6 Spiritual Energy Healing

COURSE DESCRIPTION: An exploration of the many healing arts and energy work from an Interfaith perspective.

TOPICS INCLUDED:

In-depth exploration of the herbal arts: Herbal applications, history, folklore; herbalism reference work; a practical, comprehensive illustrated herb guide covers everything from herb gathering prayers and charms to signatures for fifty powerful herbs.

Human Energy System: Far more than the "aura" and the "chakras;" explore powerful and largely unknown energy structures; simple and effective exercises; understand the structures of the Human Energy System; gain a visual perspective which empowers your ability to use your imagination to assist you in developing conscious use of the Human Energy System; an effective bridge into the boundless and timeless world of Spirit.

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Energy Healing – essentials of self-care: How the subtle energy field is as important to our well-being as our physical body is; a complete guidebook of easy-to-use energy practices to enhance our health and vitality; our subtle anatomy—understanding the chakras, meridians, and the key principles of energy medicine; self-diagnosis techniques for sensing the movement of energy in our bodies; practices for daily self-care and specific techniques to address energy blocks often seen in common illnesses and health issues; stories about how energy moves in and around us for healing— and why these stories themselves can enable us to heal; why our energy wanes as we age and how we can replenish our vitality from sources in the world around us; a study of the latest research on energy medicine and healing traditions from around the world; selected techniques that are accessible, effective, and show great long-term benefit; an indispensible guide for expanding our understanding of the energetic dimension of our well-being; and essential tools to help us take charge of our own health.

Healing intelligence of essential oils: Explores science's new biological understanding of essential oils for improved immunity and treatment of degenerative diseases; revolutionary essential oil treatments to ameliorate the side effects of allopathic treatments; simple recipes and protocols; new biological understanding of essential oils; reviewing recent research in molecular, cellular, and evolutionary biology; help to build one's immunity and overall well-being.

Experience prayer at its deepest and most profound level: Prayer as a direct channel into union with God; moving beyond the stage of "petition prayer" to a place of true openness to guidance from a higher source; how humility allows us to bypass the ego and connect directly to the Divine; the transformational journey; prayers for healing, for the morning and evening; navigating difficult times and expanding your capacity to act from a place of love; new insights into the most important tool available to us on our spiritual journey; and calling upon the grace that will never fail to guide and shelter us.

Shamanic practices for making a difference in the world: Shamanic tools for solving the challenges we face as a global community; healing practices and initiatory journeys to address pollution-based diseases, natural and man-made disasters, and environmental degradation; explores time, physics, and other dimensions to explain how to repair and evolve DNA and see into the future in order to change it; how to move beyond feeling helpless and overwhelmed by global crises so we can make a difference in the world through active participation in healing ourselves, our families, our communities, and the planet; powerful shamanic tools, such as the Heart Breath, Breaking Reality Barriers, and Transforming Fear; individuals can combine their healing intentions with the intelligent field of creation to effect tangible change.

Qigong: An integrated mind-body healing method that has been practiced with remarkable results in China for thousands of years; the Chinese have long treasured qigong for its effectiveness both in healing and in preventing disease; more recently they have used it in conjunction with modern medicine to cure cancer, immune system disorders, and other life-threatening conditions; renowned qigong master and China scholar Kenneth S. Cohen explains how you too can integrate qigong into your life and harness the healing power that will help your mind and body achieve the harmony of true health.

Course: SPHEAL B-802-6 Spiritual Energy Healing Internship

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Exploration of working with clients under the direction and mentorship of your Dean.

TOPICS INCLUDED: Maintaining proper recordkeeping and a log of the clients you see; develop a Spiritual & Energy Healing Workshop; establish your healing session protocol; record private sessions on www.counsellingtrac.com.

Course: REL B-511-6 Comparative Religious Practices

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Experiential understanding of how different religions bring spirituality to the person through specific practices.

TOPICS INCLUDED: Drawing on the wisdom of teachers from the world's great religions to deepen our appreciation of everyday routines and abundant rewards; and vivid descriptions of rituals from around the world to help us find spiritual meaning in life's key passages.

A collection of guided journeys and meditations: To help connect with and learn from power animals and spirit allies; 50 unique power animal and spirit guide meditations. What can the hawk teach you about your life purpose? What does the salmon know of fertile dreams, goal setting, and self-actualization? Calling upon the magical wisdom of nature, you are guided into the spirit world of sacred totems, oracles, and animal teachings from many cultures, including Africa, Egypt, and North America; encounter the archetypal wisdom teachings found in many animals.

A common language of love, respect, justice, peace, and hope: When our faith differences are acknowledged and supported, we are more likely to find ourselves united for Interfaith gatherings; a collection of nearly 80 prayers - prayers are grouped for easy reference, including Ordinations and Installations, Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual and Transgender Events, Dedications, Unity and Diversity, Peace and Justice, Gratitude and Remembrance; focus is on what people of all faiths can share; practical advice on how to address the holy, creating sacred space with prayer, and how to close prayers; invoke a sense of the holy and provide a common ground of belonging for everyone; beneficial for clergy, lay ministers, anyone participating in Interfaith worship and readers who want to write prayers of their own.

Human development from infancy into adulthood and beyond: Into those states described by mystics and spiritual adepts, the spiritual evolution of such extraordinary individuals as the Buddha and Jesus hints at the direction human beings will take in their continuing growth toward transcendence.

Drawing on the wisdom from the world's great religious traditions: Deepens our appreciation of such everyday routines as waking up, eating, and working, as well as the abundant rewards of enjoying music, gardening, walking, and being with others; vivid descriptions of rituals from around the world help us find new spiritual meaning in life's key passages.

Course: NPSY B-411-6 Consciousness and the Paranormal

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Development of an understanding of the language of the unconscious and superconscious through interpretation of sound, colour, symbols and dream interpretations, as well as paranormal phenomena; study of how a variety of tools can enhance the spiritual consultation process and how to determine their appropriateness with specific individuals: tools such as diaries, journaling, meditation, selfhelp groups and books, dream and symbol interpretation, prayer, letter writing, hypnosis, regression, biofeedback, humour, mandalas, aura readings for wellness and for healing, chakra or energy awareness and alignment, affirmations, and RGI \clubsuit ^{PLUS} technique will be explored.

TOPICS INCLUDED:

History of Consciousness Exploration: Shamanistic Traditions, Ancient Mesopotamia, Ancient India & Yoga, Ancient China & Taoism, Ancient Greece & Oracles, Pythagoras, Democritus, Socrates, Plato, Aristotle and Neoplatonism, Ancient Rome, Ancient Hebrews and early Christians, Islamic explorations,

Medieval explorations, Renaissance and the Age of Enlightenment.

Folklore of Consciousness Exploration: Astrology, astral projection and out-of-body experiences; healing (temples, mesmerism, animal magnetism, faith healing, radionics, Edgar Cayce, psychic surgery, delusion and fraud, healing at Lourdes, mental imagery, Omega techniques); spiritual anatomy (thoughtforms, aura, auric colours and their meaning, the vital body, the chakras, Chinese acupuncture, William Reich and Orgone energy, the Soviet concept of biological plasma, high-voltage photography, the phantom leaf effect and Kurt Lewin's field theory); communication with higher intelligence (angels and guardian spirits, the Master, Cabala, Emmanuel Swedenborg, psychophysics, the Theosophical Society, the Course in Miracles, the Invisible College); Other Worlds (UFO's, Fatima, teleportation).

Life Within Death: Death within Life (survival of consciousness after death, the *Tibetan Book of the Dead*, Spiritualism, Spiritism, the Society for Psychical Research, apparitions and hauntings, near-death experiences, mediumship, reincarnation); unusual powers of mind over matter (D.D. Home, Sir William Crooke, Marthe Beraud, psychic photography, Uri Geller, Poltergeist cases, lightning striking, weather control, fire-walking); practical applications of psychic awareness (harmful purpose, national security applications, ancient history and folklore, accident prevention, dowsing, treasure hunting, accuracy of information, psychic archeology, psychic police work, journalism and investigative reporting, history, precognition in business, public safety, education, creativity in art, music and literature, agriculture and pest control, athletics and sports, finding lost items, scientific discovery, weather predictions and control, animal training and intuitive consensus).

The Scientific Exploration of Consciousness: Intro; difficulties; to err is human; illusions; ESP; J. B. Rhine; Hypnotherapy and ESP; precognition; psychokinesis; psionics; proper scientific controls for ESP experimentation; evaluating Psi research.

Theories of Consciousness: The biological perspective; the new physics; the reflexive universe; a hyper-space view of consciousness.

A Look at the Meaning of Symbols: A survey of the abundance of types of human symbolic thinking; diverse cultural interpretations of the same symbol; and an essential guide to interpreting symbols through dreams and other visioning techniques.

Course: NPSY B-410-3 Psychic Studies – Advanced

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Exploration of experiential psychic practices as gifts of Spirit and healing tools.

TOPICS INCLUDED:

Psychic healing techniques: Once assumed to be too esoteric to use without highly specialized knowledge, years of training, and a paranormal gift - helps us tap into the potent healing power of our own psychic energies; the beginner - theory and instruction in basic meditation, visualization, kundalini energy, chakras, and auras; the intermediate level - spirit guides and angels, how to use healing crystals, hands-on healing methods, emotional release work, and remote healing; advanced program - healing karma and past lives, soul retrieval, releasing entities, spirit attachments, and understanding and aiding the death process.

"Emotional emergency kit:" Offers simple exercises for transforming seven negative emotions into positive thinking and living; follow the easy-to-use action steps to transform: Fear into Courage, Frustration into Patience, Loneliness into Connection, Anxiety into Inner Calm, Depression into Hope, Jealousy into Self-Esteem, Anger into Compassion.

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"We are the keepers of an intuitive intelligence so powerful it can tell us how to heal:" The heart of a radical revolution in health care - the union of medicine and intuition, of body, mind, and soul; five practical steps which illustrate how to harness the power of intuition to heal; skills to uncover important information from meditation and remote viewing (a way of intuitively tuning in) to make sense of confusing signals; simple, clear instructions, illustrated with examples.


